THIS IS WHAT WILPF INTERNATIONAL SECRETARIAT PLANS TO DO

Here's a glimpse of what we'll do to celebrate the launch of our zine and our commitment to environmental justice:

• 5 JUNE

We will launch our zine and communication campaign about WILPF's environmental commitment and our feminist eco-pacifist perspective.

• 6 JUNE - 6 JULY

We will raise awareness about the interrelation between the environment, gender, and peace and share our best practices on how to take grassroots action against climate change and its effects

• 14 JUNE - 6 JULY

We will draw attention to the challenges our Sections and Groups are facing by sharing videos presenting their environmental projects.

· 2 JULY

A webinar will take place to talk together about the zine and have a discussion with speakers from different organisations.

• 7 - 16 JULY

We will participate in the annual High-Level Political Forum (HLPF) on Sustainable Development. WILPF will be continuing its work on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) promoting an integrated approach that connects environmental issues, gender equality, human rights and disarmament.

· AFTER JULY

Environmental dates will be opportunities for WILPF to raise awareness of environmental issues and speak out about our feminist perspective for a greener future.

WHO IS OUR TARGET AUDIENCE FOR THE LAUNCH OF THE ZINE?

Our primary target audience is young women activists, who are not necessarily familiar with WILPF.

They are between 14 and 35 years old, interested in climate security and eco-feminism, or are engaged in and passionate about environmental issues.

BY ADAPTING OUR MESSAGE TO THEM WE WANT TO:

- Encourage the adoption of a feminist peace perspective that links environmental degradation and ecological injustice to economic and social factors that fuel and are fueled by global militarism.
- Encourage them to become members of WILPF.
- Encourage them to recognise, trust, and support our work and vision by actively sharing our material.
